If you are experiencing food insecurity you can apply for SNAP which can give your household a monthly EBT card to purchase food.

APPLY FOR WIC Call 610-258-6938

Pregnant women, women with babies and small children and legal guardians of children under age 5 can apply for WIC. Families with children in school or daycare can apply for free meals for their children at their school or childcare center. Qualification for SNAP, WIC and school/childcare meals is based on family income.

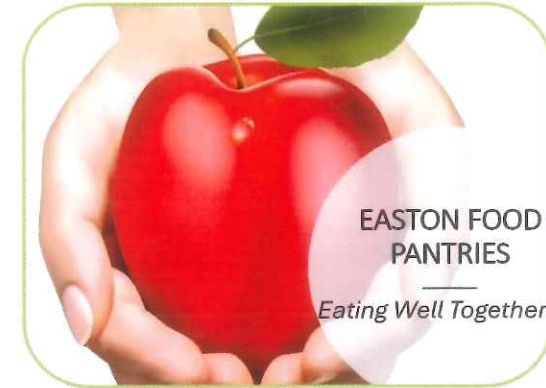
